Twinkle Twinkle

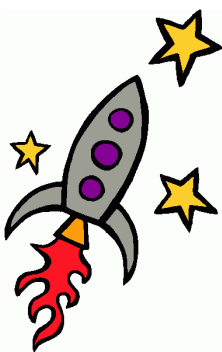
Twinkle, twinkle little star Twinkle,
